The Residential Unit provides care 24 hours per day, 7 days a week. Applicants will be required to work on a rotating roster. Tresillian will consider applicants who have a preference in working mostly night duty shifts. The Registered Nurse and/or Midwife will provide a standard of excellence according to the individual's level of experience and education for all clients and families by implementing and maintaining high quality primary health care within a safe environment.

The Registered Nurse and/or Midwife will create an environment that facilitates working in partnership with clients and families in decision making, provision of care and the maintenance of quality primary health care services. They will analyse current trends and grow in professional awareness by being aware of developments locally, nationally and internationally, specifically in child and family health.
